5 GCSE course - one year course where you can follow different pathways. Science Pathway – ideal for students who wish to study Science A Level, Health and Social Care pathway – aimed at students who want to work in the health industry and Business, Art and Media pathway – this is aimed for the more creative students. All pathways include **English** and **Maths**.

Other pathways, along with **English** and **Maths**; you will choose 3 subjects from the following: GCSE Business, GCSE History, GCSE Art, GCSE Media, GCSE Biology and GCSE Citizenship.

A good standard of English and Maths is required to be enrolled on this course; if you have previously studied GCSE we would expect that you have achieved a grade 3 (D) in both English and Maths.

Can also do GCSE **English** and **Maths** or functional alongside vocational courses.

English AQA GCSE English Language – Will need to have gained a GCSE grade D or 3, a functional skills qualification at Level 2. If this is not the case then an assessment may be carried out.

Mathematics AQA GCSE Linear Foundation Course – This course allows you to gain a grade 4/5. The course is designed as a revision course for those who are one grade off a grade 4.

All students are required to have gained a GCSE grade D (3) in Maths or functional skills level 2.
