

DO YOU WANT TO OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT?

HOW CAN YOU OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT?

During the current Lockdown, you can open a bank or building society account either online or over the phone

You will need to provide the bank with some identification, but the bank will tell you how you can do this

If you plan to visit a branch, it is a good idea to book an appointment (check how to do this with the bank you have chosen).

WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO OPEN AN ACCOUNT?

Identification

Anti-fraud and anti-money laundering procedures mean that banks will need you to provide ID. Without the correct ID your application is likely to be rejected.

You can consider using a Provisional or full Driving Licence, a Passport, or Birth Certificate. Your National Insurance Number may be useful too.

Proof of Address

You could consider using any official letters (benefit agency, tax, medical letters), a recent bill (phone bill), or a letter from a Professional, a School or a College.
